- § 20-129(c) Without burning headlamps on motorcycle.
- § 20-129(d) Without burning rear lamps on motorcycle.
- § 20-138.1(a) Driving while impaired.
- § 20-138.3 Driving while impaired by provisional licensee.
- § 20-138.7(a)(1) Transporting an open container of alcoholic beverage.
- § 20-138.7(a)(2) Transporting an open container of alcoholic beverage after consuming.

- § 20-140(b) Reckless driving (careless and reckless driving).
- § 20-140.2 Operating overloaded or overcrowded vehicle.
- § 20-140.4(a)(1) Motorcycle with greater number of passengers than designed to carry.

- § 20-140.4(a)(2) Operating motorcycle without wearing safety helmet.
- § 20-141(a) Exceeding safe speed.
- § 20-141.4(a1) Death by vehicle (felony).
- § 20-141.4(a2) Death by vehicle (misdemeanor)
